Kitty Cat Connection respectfully asks the prospective caregiver (adopter) to agree with the following adoption requirements and information:

1. Cats are to live indoors in a private residence as companion animals.
2. Caregiver will provide the cat with sufficient quantities of nutritious food, fresh water and with a clean litter box daily.
3. Caregiver will never strike or otherwise harm the cat.
4. Declawing is not a procedure KCC recommends. Declawing is removing part of the cat's digit, not just the nail. This is a painful procedure that carries a real risk of crippling deformation and serious behavior changes. There are scratching posts, clipping nail tips and other humane means to keep a cat from scratching the furniture or leaving nail marks. Consult your veterinarian before giving thought to this procedure. Ask him/her to explain the procedure to you, in depth, before considering this. (We often have declawed cats for adoption)
5. All of our fostered cats are spayed or neutered when they old enough. We offer only spayed or neutered cats for adoption. **Sterilization is required pursuant to sections 273.400 to 273.405, Missouri Revised Statutes.**
6. Caregiver will ensure that the cat's vaccinations for rabies and distemper remain current and will provide veterinary care upon sickness, disease or injury. We strive to provide a healthy cat and we provide initial appropriate vaccinations and spaying/neutering but we cannot guarantee perfect health or be responsible for future veterinarian expenses. **Cats must leave adoption site in a pet carrier**
7. Caregiver allows Kitty Cat Connection visitation rights to ensure that the terms of this adoption agreement are being observed. Caregiver promises to respond to telephone followup from foster parent. Caregiver will be given oral and written advice on introducing the cat to its new home. Following this advice will prevent many common problems with new adoptions.
8. Adoption is a lifetime commitment, but if the cat must be given up for any reason by the prospective caregiver, PLEASE make any member of Kitty Cat Connection your first telephone call. Do not surrender the adopted cat to a shelter or an irresponsible individual or worse, abandon it on the street or roadside. Caregiver **MUST NOT** turn the cat over to a humane society, shelter or person, but must return the cat to Kitty Cat Connection. If the phone number and/or address for Kitty Cat Connection is no longer operative, the caregiver will make a good faith effort to locate and contact any member of Kitty Cat Connection.
9. Caregiver understands that failure to perform the foregoing will constitute a breach of this agreement. In the event of any such breach of agreement, caregiver authorizes Kitty Cat Connection to reclaim possession of the adopted cat. In return for the above conditions, Kitty Cat Connection agrees to allow the prospective caregiver to adopt the cat named on the front page of this agreement.
